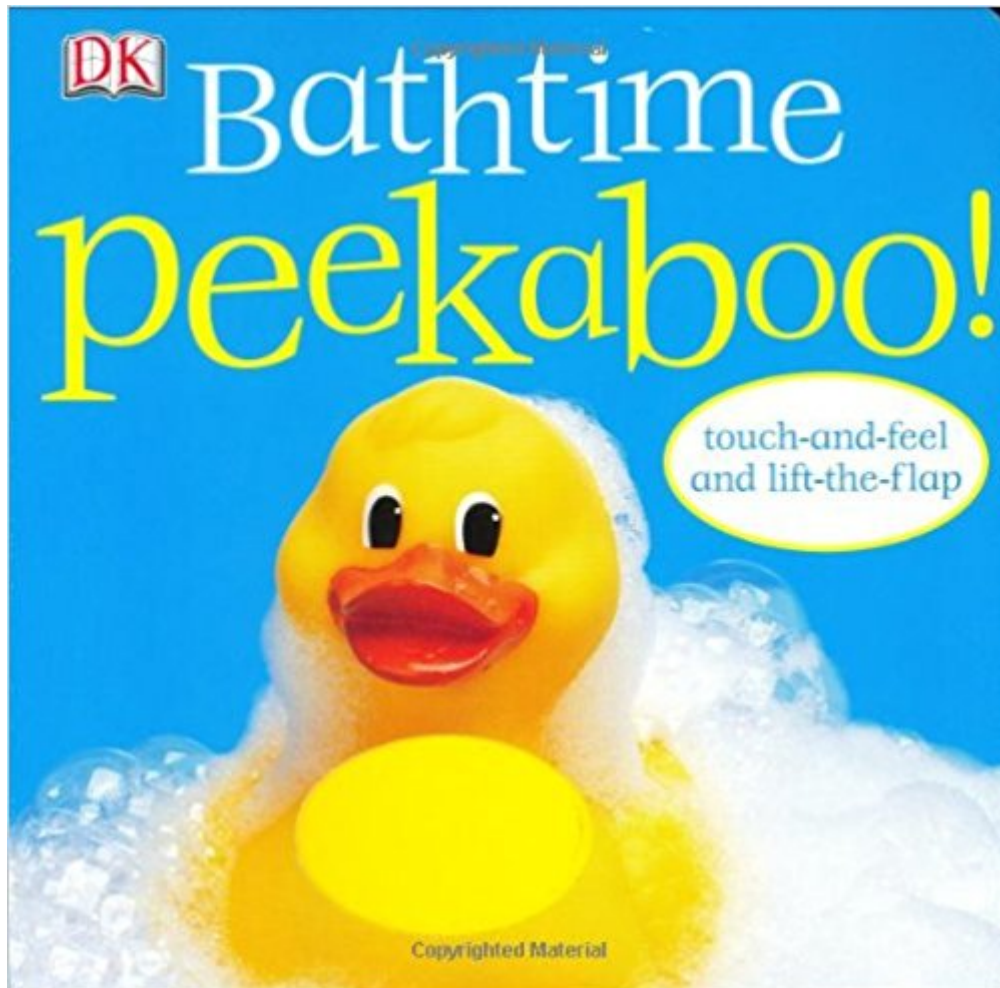

After reading all the reviews, I thought this book was going to be great, but it isn't. The textures just aren't that great, and one of them isn't even a texture... a "yellow" duck? Where the touch and feel cutaway reveals a piece of yellow, shiny cardboard? What does this teach? That rubber ducks feel like books? That yellow is a texture? The bumpy starfish is similarly disappointing, again just cardboard but with a few bits that are raised. I bought this book because my son loves the Animal Hide-and-Seek book by Usborne, and I was looking for something similar. But that book has wonderful textures and a great hide and seek element, whereas here the textures are underwhelming and the peekaboo flaps are awkwardly designed (they open out of the edges in the opposite way that the page turns, so that they look to him just like confusing pages, not flaps). The only nice thing is that the flaps are very sturdy cardboard, so not likely to get torn up.

Cute

This was the first book that my son ever became interested in! I introduced it to him around 3 months as part of a bathtime routine. It has wonderful pictures and the pages are very shiny which makes it intriguing for their little eyes. I even ordered Bathtime Peekaboo after seeing how much he liked this one! :)

My one-year-old son loves these books, and so do his parents. The flaps are made from the same material as the rest of the board book, so unlike most of his other lift-the-flaps, these books stand up well to heavy "reading." The textures are great, and so are the pictures of the real babies. It's a genius series combining many elements babies love -- sturdy flaps, interesting textures, baby pictures, everyday objects, and engaging text. That being said, this is not the greatest book in the series. The textures are a little dull. Several are just variations on cardboard. My son still enjoys the book, but the textures aren't engaging or worth exploring. I recommend trying other titles first. We love *Peekaboo Playtime* and *Baby Loves*.

I wasn't really a fan of this book when I first got it, but after seeing my daughter laugh and have so much fun lifting the "flaps" (they're more like extra pages) I have to give it a pretty high rating :) The touch and feel aspect could be better in my opinion. But other than that it's great. I think the pictures being photos really captures my daughters attention.

We have many of these Peekaboo books, in large and small formats, but this is the absolute favorite of every baby who has come into our house (including our own two little ones). There's something about the cheerful rubber ducky on the front and the fact that the whole book is centered around baths that babies seem to find extra-appealing. The whole series is pretty fun, but this one is a baby favorite.

As is the case with ALL of the DK Publishing "Peekaboo" books we have purchased (which is about 12), they are adorable and incredibly high quality. My one year old daughter and two year old son are in love with these books. They have only managed to tear up 2 of them, but only after at least a year of very intense play. I have been THRILLED with them. I bought 4 for my friend's daughter as well.

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
