

This absolutely did the trick for passing the PRAXIS the very first time! If you're considering the newer edition versus this one, I'd say go for this one... My roommate bought the newer edition, and while it's nice to have updated information (such as the DSM-V classification of autism spectrum

disorders), this will do just fine for the sake of studying for the PRAXIS.

This PRAXIS review book is very comprehensive, very nicely organized, and contains practice questions that I feel reflect what the PRAXIS exam contains. The information in this book may also be useful later in your career as it contains a good overview of lots of disorders and concepts. There are tiny gaps where I feel more information could be included about certain things (like spectrograms, speech science specifics, DSM-V information, Common Core information, MBSS images, etc.), but the book is still very informative and can help you understand what you should study from your classroom materials. This particular book does not include a flashdrive, and I would have loved if the book had a real-life practice test (with 120 questions and their answers/scoring). Instead, I took the practice test provided by ETS and rented the "Mosby's Review Questions for the SLP Praxis" from my university library.

ALL you need to pass the Praxis is a good education and this book! I was dreading studying for the test, but I ended up really enjoying reading the Advanced Review, and passed with flying colors! I had friends who went through Pro-Ed to get the drive, but I thought the practice questions at the end of each chapter were enough! Seriously, don't buy other praxis materials! I made the mistake of buying two books prior to this one that were worthless to me!

A flashdrive with practice tests should come along with this book. I would not advise purchasing this book without the accompanying flashdrive. For the money, you can buy this through ASHA or ProEd **WITH** the flashdrive. I hope you learn from my mistake.

You need this if you're going to take the PRAXIS.

Easy to read and useful, though one needs to read it with caution - it contains more than a few factual errors; hopefully fixed in later editions. But I used it and passed, so it did what it was supposed to.

There are a few errors within the text, but overall it's a good resource for the Praxis. I used this edition to pass the Praxis this past March.

I truly believe this helped me pass my exam! The practice questions were really realistic to what the

test actually looked like.

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
