

Fame led the parade of dance films in the early 1980s, and its Oscar-winning score by Michael Gore and Dean Pitchford holds up very well. This book includes all the major numbers from the film, including the throbbering title tune (also an Oscar winner), the funky "Hot Lunch Jam," the youth anthem "I Sing the Body Electric," and that staple of '80s vocal recitals, "Out Here on My Own." Even the solo piano ballad "Ralph and Monty (Dressing Room Piano)" is here. Serious fans know that Paul McCrane sang "Is It Okay If I Call You Mine?" (which he wrote) and "Dogs in the Yard" years before he became Dr. "Rocket" Romano on television's ER. --David Horiuchi

I absolutely love the book. I think it's a commendable source of music soundtracks from the movie. If you are more of a proficient musician, however, you might find it a bit too simplified and omitted (in respect of the actual music setting). Nevertheless, the book provides sufficient foundation for further arrangements and improvisations on the piano and other instruments as well.
