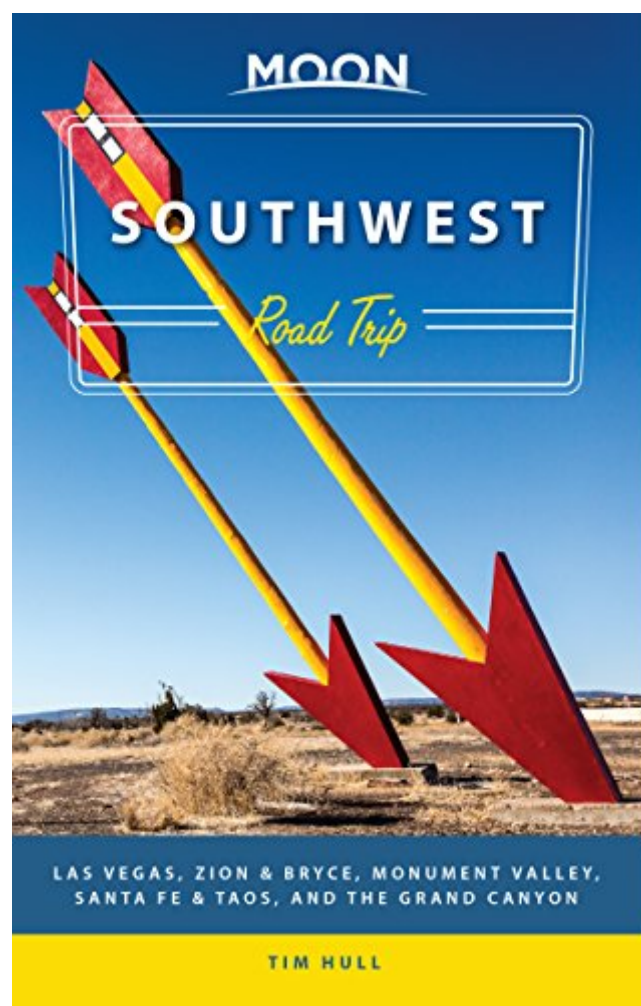

My favorite feature of the book(other than the maps or course) is that he gives you recommendations on what to see depending on how much time you have. For example...if you just have a few hours, a whole day, or more. Just the way I think. He also shows the driving times between destinations. Exactly what I needed. Based on the book I did prioritize and skip some things (Bryce canyon for example) that I knew I just did not have the time to see. I used this book more for the parks information and driving, not so much for places to eat or motels. It does have some sections on New Mexico I think, but I did not go there. Excellent guide and book.
