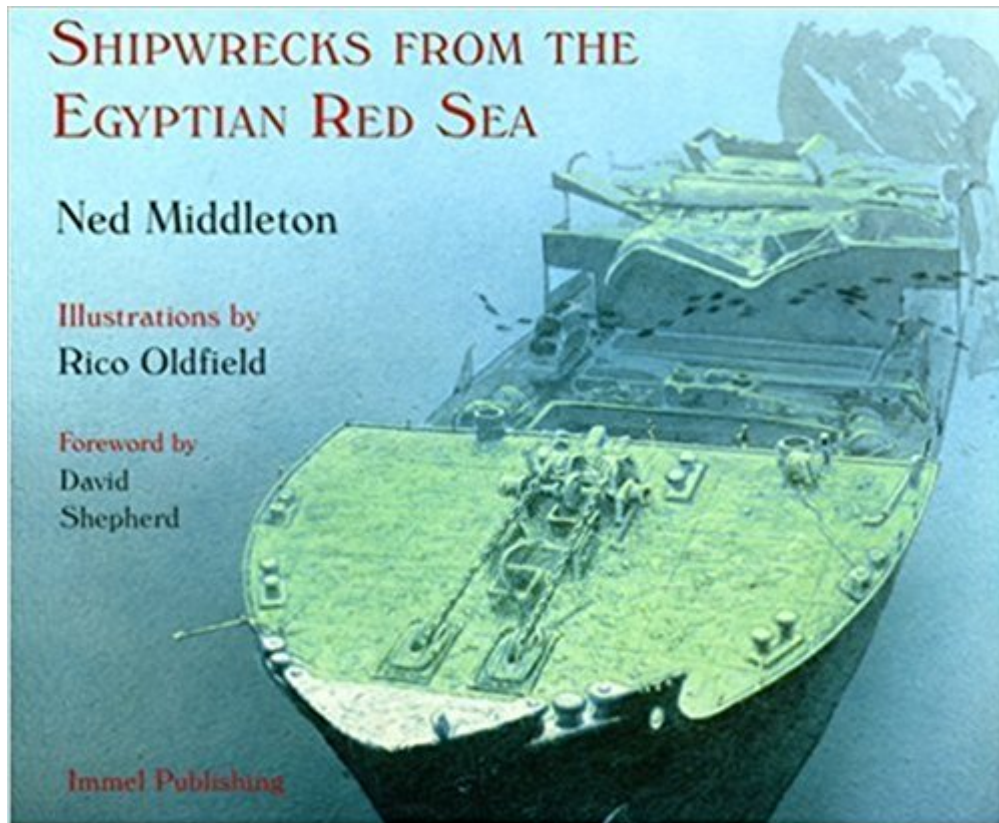




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Shipwrecks From The Egyptian Red Sea

The wreck of the Thistlegorm has consistently remained the world's most visited dive site for the past ten years. This well researched and heavily illustrated work contains details of seventeen wrecks, ten of which have never been described or illustrated before in any book. A final chapter includes miscellaneous shipwrecks, providing a solid research base for any one wishing to know more of the story behind these epic sites. Each ship is described in detail and illustrated in its final glory, a narrative of each ship's last journey is provided as well as diving details - personally researched by the author - giving underwater descriptions of each vessel - from one end of the ship to the other. Finally, the artist's stunning impression of each shipwreck in its entirety concludes each individual ship's chapter.

I have just been lucky enough to sit through the lecture that accompanies this book and its amazing. First to the book itself, I bought the hardcopy 1st edition as opposed to the soft copy 2nd edition, by Ned's own admission there is not much changed so it's just a person preference. The book itself is a work of art, the author spends 100s of hours researching each wreck from the original Lloyd's registry to local hearsay and this is evidenced in his book, he refutes local folklore that has grown around some of these wrecks and produces his factual back up, additionally he gets the background to the captains which is very enlightening. The book's content is a mixture of amazing photos and drawings. These drawings are rendered from 1000's of photos taken by Ned and arranged to get a true detailed underwater picture which is then rendered into fantastic pictures. The photos are all of a great quality and have not been photoshopped like some recent publications; in fact most are direct prints from film! If you want a truly good guide to the Red Sea wrecks that is not bogged down into biased ego then buy this book. If you love maritime history then buy this book.
