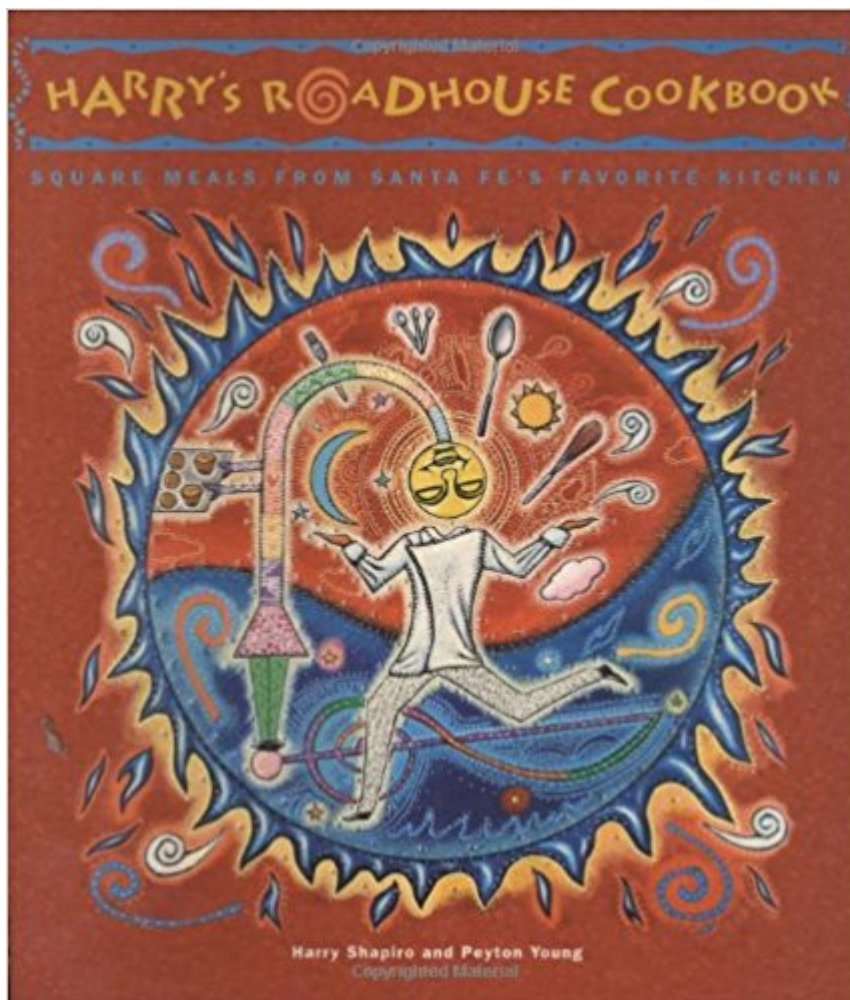

Double Chocolate Espresso Brownies Prep time: 20 minutes Turnout time: 45 minutes Special

equipment: stand mixer, cookie sheet, parchment paper 1 cup unsweetened chocolate 1/2 pound butter 2 tablespoons espresso 6 eggs 3/4 teaspoon salt 3 cups sugar 2 cups flour 1/2 cup walnuts 1/4 cup semisweet chocolate, chopped Melt the unsweetened chocolate and butter in a double boiler or your microwave. Don't let it burn if you use a microwave. Heat for 30 seconds, remove and stir. Heat 30 seconds more until smooth, but not hot. Add the espresso or strong brewed coffee. You could substitute instant espresso powder if you have it. Beat the eggs with the salt until foamy. Add the sugar and beat on high for 5 minutes until the mixture doubles in volume. Put the chocolate mixture in a large bowl. Fold in the egg mixture. Combine until smooth, but trying not to depress the egg volume. Sift in the 2 cups of flour and stir until smooth. Fold in the chopped semi sweet chocolate and the nuts. Spray a 9X 11-inch pan with Pam and line with parchment paper. Pour batter into the prepared pan and bake for 45 minutes. After they cool cut the brownies to desired size. These are incredibly rich, fudge like, and a little goes a long way. I love them warm with a little ice cream. One of our most popular desserts is a Brownie Sundae with Hot Fudge, Pecan-Bourbon Carmel Sauce, Vanilla Haagen Dazs and Whipped Cream. In my opinion it serves four, but some people eat the whole thing themselves.

One of my favorite cookbooks! Harry's Roadhouse was one of my favorite restaurants when I lived in Santa Fe. When I moved away, I missed a lot of my favorite dishes. Now, I make them using the original recipes and they look and taste just like I remember. Moroccan Stew, Strawberry Rhubarb pie, and the Roadhouse Hippie salad are just a few of my favorites.

My wife and I went on a 1200 kilometer bicycletrip to the USA this summer (2010), from Denver to Albuquerque. As we didn't have a defined plan, the road led us past Harry's Roadhouse on our way to the Santa Fe KOA. We stopped, we lunched, we were totally sold! Great people, great restaurant, excellent food. So when we were back in Holland, (the Netherlands) we surfed the Internet for info on this great place. Found the book on , bought it, and when we do our 'homemade version' of Harry's food it's a little bit like we're there again...

Fun cookbook, different recipes, go to book. Not difficult to follow. The peach cobbler is amazing. Bought this book for my children and friends.

I received the book promptly. I'm truly enjoying the recipes and hope to prepare two new ones each week. A friend of mine had the cookbook and I thought I would really enjoy it.
