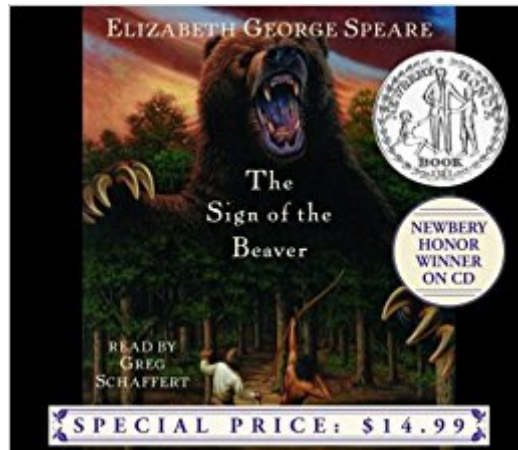

When his father returns East to collect the rest of the family, 13-year-old Matt is left alone to guard his family's newly built homestead. One day, Matt is brutally stung when he robs a bee tree for honey. He returns to consciousness to discover that his many stings have been treated by an old Native American and his grandson. Matt offers his only book as thanks, but the old man instead asks Matt to teach his grandson Attean to read. Both boys are suspicious, but Attean comes each day for his lesson. In the mornings, Matt tries to entice Attean with tales from Robinson Crusoe, while in the afternoons, Attean teaches Matt about wilderness survival and Native American culture. The boys become friends in spite of themselves, and their inevitable parting is a moving tribute to the ability of shared experience to overcome prejudice. The Sign of the Beaver was a Newbery Honor Book; author Elizabeth Speare has also won the Newbery Medal twice, for *The Witch of Blackbird Pond* and *The Bronze Bow*. Our book club meets once a year with boys who are court ordered to a facility where they live and go to school. They read this book and 20 of the members came and brought food and discussed the book. They had good insight and many boys offered discussion about the book. It was a good choice for this occasion.

Good value for money

We are reading The Sign of the Beaver as a 5th grade class and my students are thoroughly enjoying it. We read a chapter a day and then we discuss it completely. I am allowing 2 students to lead the class for every 2 chapters. They teach it and write down questions to discuss with their peers. We have made a Native American Dictionary and will be writing stories or letters as an activity. There are so many great projects to choose from for this novel. I have given teacher-made assessments after every 2 chapters and a comprehensive test for the first 10 chapters. I would highly recommend it for any 4th or 5th grade classroom.
