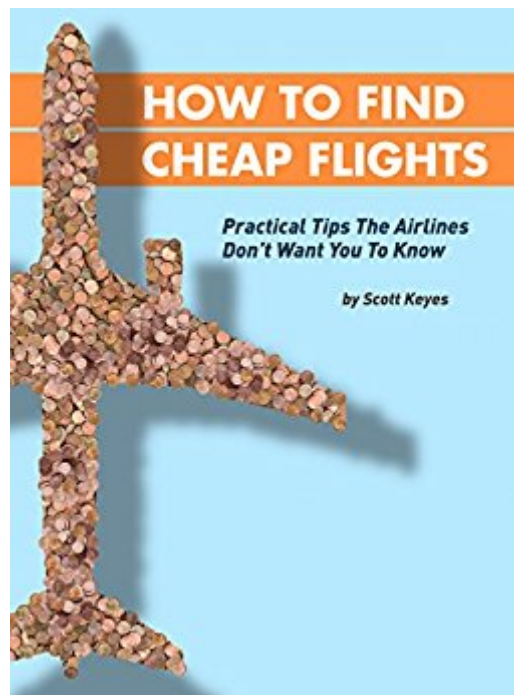




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How To Find Cheap Flights: Practical Tips The Airlines Don't Want You To Know
