

I was a little skeptical, but curious, when I got this book, as to how well 26 authors could write a cohesive novel, that could keep me interested. It was a most happy surprise, when it not only held together, but kept me turning page after page, to find out how it would end.

This is an engrossing, equally gripping story of a woman named Rosemary who is on death row, accused of murdering her unfaithful, remorseless husband, Christopher Thomas. The story centers around the events before and after the murder. The plot alternates between the past and the present and the 26 authors had outdone themselves in executing the novel so seamlessly. Even though each author has a particular "tone" to the story, the nuance is very subtle and the plot flows very smoothly. I'm the type of girl who likes to stick to the same authors and rarely like to try someone new. So by reading this novel, it helped give me a glimpse of the writing style and creativity of other authors I'm not familiar with and truth be told, I'm impressed by their prose, albeit the chapters were too short. The host of characters are complex and interesting. I suppose my only gripe is that I felt that a few of the characters weren't as fleshed-out, at least, not to what I'm accustomed to in a novel. That said, it doesn't subtract from the plot's overall enjoyability. In my many readings, I don't recall hating a character as much as I hated Christopher Thomas. It wasn't long before I started reading that I wanted to off him myself! The authors have managed to paint him as a person with no redeeming qualities whatsoever. Rosemary is a kind, guileless character and the opening chapter describing the eve of her execution had really affected me. It really made me question and re-evaluate my stance on the death penalty. Half-way through the novel, I've tried to deduce who the "guilty party" was, so it came as a surprise that the ending wasn't what I thought it would be. I usually read who-dun-it mysteries, so the ending came as sort of a shock to me. If you're

anything like me, half of the enjoyment of reading a mystery is trying to play "detective" and figure out who the perpetrator is, then this book is worth your while. I really do hope that these talented authors collaborate again and give us another treat sometime in the near future.

Prepare to be glued to NO REST FOR THE DEAD. This book is loaded with characters and actions that keep the reader wanting more. The plot revolves around a former police officer trying to solve a mystery which has haunted him for twelve years. His obsession with finding justice for a woman whom he believes was unjustly sentenced to death has taken over his life. He feels responsible for her fate, because his testimony in court helped convict her of murdering her husband. He will stop at nothing to learn who the real killer is and bring him or her to justice. There isn't a slow or dull portion of this book. I literally read it until my eyes ached. This book is definitely worth at least the five stars I am giving it!

I really enjoyed this book and I especially liked reading a different chapter by different authors. It was interesting to me to see and feel the difference of each authors writing style technique. They kept the story interesting and action packed. True to David Balducci's introduction, I really thought I was figuring out who did it and then as fast as I thought I figured it out my suspect would change. Finding out who done it was really surprising! This read was like playing the board game "Clue" only you didn't need all the players on hand. Really enjoyed the game!!!! Bravo!!!! Well done!!!!

I have come across a few books like this where various authors come together to write a book of one story or common theme/thread throughout and always find them interesting just because of having to put the book together in that manner, and I probably will tend to be predisposed to liking it a bit more. I have not seen one in awhile though. That being said, this was one of the good ones in this style, which is not surprising considering some of the authors involved in the process. The story line is not particularly unique - someone, who is perhaps innocent who is wrongfully accused of a crime, together with the ramifications and doubts of those involved in the case. How the authors bring it together makes it special. A gripping read that is well worth it.

I wasn't sure what to expect from this, given the long and illustrious cast of writers. Part of my concern was that each writer has such a distinctive voice when writing on his or her own. But it all came together well. The advantage of the multiple viewpoints, was that it allowed the reader to experience multiple points of view. One writer might write from the perspective of a cop; another

from the victim's point of view, etc. Generally this was an enjoyable read.
