

I have had two other guides in this series (Tokyo and Lisbon) and recommend for short trips. Ideal for, say, if you have a one-day layover or are spending a weekend. In the case of the Los Angeles guide, I had about a day and a half. I like them because I can get straight to the heart of the key things to see and do in a short timeframe. They aren't good for extensive advance planning (I rely on internet research or other research at home for that). They are nice and compact...with a pullout map. The map in my experience is useful, but could be more so. Often, the detail is too minimal to be truly great. Again, got a smartphone, so it's not the be all end all, but is handy for a reference. I will, however, in the future, plan enough in advance to get a paper version. What I loved about it--small, handy size, pull out map, easy reference, was a little negated by reading on my kindle (or, in this case, kindle app on my phone). I don't know about you, but my phone drains of battery constantly while traveling--between using as a camera, GPS, phone, guidebook, etc...so, it's nice to have something that I can flip through. Still, I liked the guide and would buy again!

Well organized by neighborhood with good maps, but for me it had too many restaurants and not

enough on attractions.

Quite helpful during my stay in L.A., it pointed out some very interesting things to see and do. I was there with a local and he agreed that most of the things I could find on the guide were worth a visit. All the informations were very up to date. I bought the kindle edition and read it mostly on my smartphone. I fund very useful the direct links to google maps, which made very simple to find the places pointed out in the guide.

I had never been to LA and was planning on a 4 day trip. Being a huge Lonely Planet fan, I got the pocket size guide, which I have to say was a brilliant idea so you can carry it around without looking like a lost tourist.. The maps are good, and the big one helpful to get an idea of LA and neighborhoods. If you are looking for specific streets etc, I recommend the GPS on your phone, it will be easier. Some recommendations were very good (Santa Monica boutiques, Getty Villa in Malibu, VIP pass for Universal studio). if you are a huge cocktail/wine/bar fan, this is the guide. Unfortunately this is not really my stuff so I wished there would be more variety (clubbing for egg.) Overall a good investment.

This guide is very good and is very readable. So many stories are set in the greater Los Angeles area, this book is helpful in following the movements of such characters and learning about the environments in which they are operating. This book is also good for tourists or want-to-be-tourists who plan to visit the LA region. Good restaurants, sights and hotels are listed. The topics are organized in a convenient, easy to find way. I recommend it heartily.
