

Anyone interested in the rich history and beauty of Virginia's early settlements will find much to treasure in this beautiful book. The insightful introduction by DeSamper, formerly with the Colonial Williamsburg Foundation, provides an excellent historical background. The camera captures the best of each season, from the brooding mists of a Yorktown autumn day to the riotous spring colors of a Williamsburg garden. The colonial dress and absence of 20th-century paraphernalia create a time warp for the reader: one sees life as it was, entering the busy doings of an important colonial city or the activities of a Powhatan Indian village. The accompanying quotations from diaries, letters, and speeches of the period add to the understanding of this triangular cradle of early American history. The historic triangle on the Virginia Peninsula holds some of the best of America's colonial heritage, including its first permanent English settlement at Jamestown, a famous hotbed of colonial dissent at the former state capital at Williamsburg, and the Revolutionary War's final major battlefield at Yorktown. Much has been preserved, and much more restored, at these three sites for the benefit of modern visitors. "Williamsburg, Jamestown, Yorktown: America's Historic Triangle" is a very nice coffee-table format picture book capturing some of the best of these three sites. It includes an informative introduction to their history, and many pages of quality photographs. The restored

Colonial Williamsburg gets the bulk of the coverage, but the sections devoted to Jamestown and Yorktown are very adequate. The book's images predate digital photography, but it still makes for a memorable souvenir of a visit. Recommended, even in used condition.
