

If you need to be reminded or encouraged about what God has called you to do, as a mom, this book is for you.

I think this book provides a great starting point for mothers. Sally Clarkson's tone is warm and encouraging and fairly realistic. (I say "fairly" because there were a few lines I read that seemed kind of saccharine-y, for lack of an actual word). It isn't "perfect", but I think every mother should read it and consider its applications to her family. I had just given birth to my third child when I read it, and I wish I'd read it sooner. There are many gems I took from it, but I think the most important one was to use challenging times and illnesses as an opportunity to express my love to my children -- rather than just trying to survive the rough patches. And it's for that reason, that I highly recommend this book.

I first read this book in 2008, and it completely transformed the trajectory of motherhood for me. There is no formula here, but there is vision and there is inspiration for how to raise your children to be light-bearers for the Kingdom of God. Love, love, love this book. I go back to it again and again!

If I could give just one book to a mom, this would be the one. It is my absolute favorite book on mothering! I have led multiple groups of women through reading and discussing this book. *Mission of Motherhood* is a grace-filled book about the incredibly important job of mothering and raising children who love Jesus.
