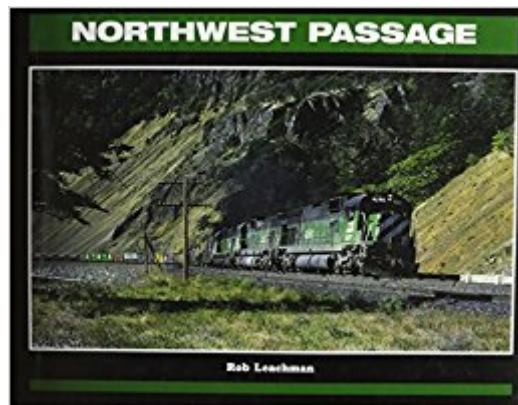


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Northwest Passage: Twenty-Five Years Of The Burlington Northern In The Pacific Northwest
