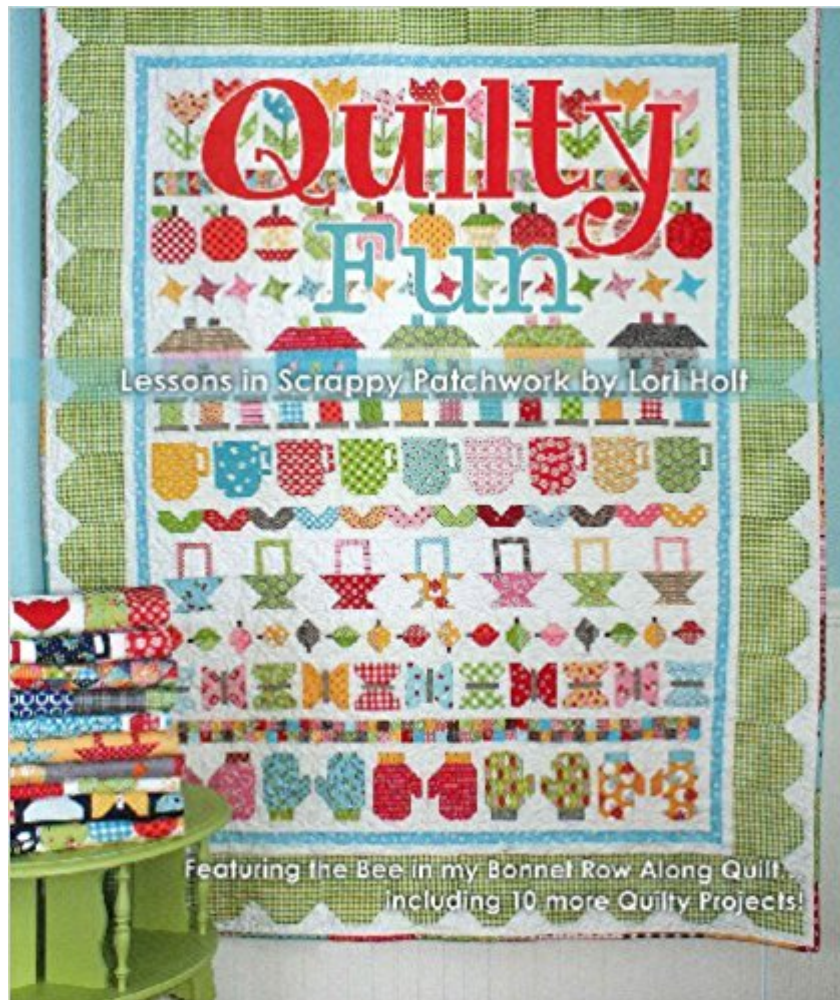

I have found one thing, right off the bat, and that is the writer did not tell you how many yards of colored fabric you need to do the blocks. It tells you how much background, border and backing, but just says scrapes for the colored parts of the block. I am not a scrappy quilt person, so I do not have scraps. Since quilt shop grade fabric is so expensive, I am going to plan on 4 yards and hope that will be enough.
