

Sixteen of his books have reached the New York Times best-seller list (seven in the number one spot) and have also appeared on the USA Today, Publisher's Weekly and Wall Street Journal best-seller lists. Tim LaHaye is an internationally known author, teacher, and expert on Bible prophecy. He is married to Beverly, who is the founder of the largest women's organization in America, Concerned Women for America. The LaHayes live in southern California.

Other than "The Rising", this is basically my least favorite book in the main series. Some parts are very neat and exciting, but it's also the most tragic and frustrating. Note: I will be revealing some items that occur, so if you don't want to know what happens, you better skip this part. The main thing that makes it frustrating is that 4 major good characters are killed, 3 of which are some of the biggest characters in the series- Chloe, Buck and Tsion. The worst part is Chloe who extremely foolishly wanders out on her own and gets caught. Part of what makes it frustrating is that the book wastes a lot of time with her in custody, leaving you expecting that she will escape, but she never does. After a long time, she is finally beheaded, something that never should have happened with her. I was rather upset with the authors when I got to this part. Another good character, Albie also gets killed after going off on a foolish mission by himself. I ended up skipping most of these parts the second time I read it. Another thing that's frustrating about this book is that there gets to be too many characters, it gets kind of hard to keep track of them all.

I really enjoyed "Armageddon." It was in my opinion the most exciting book of The Left Behind series yet. As the battle began I was on the edge of my seat waiting to see what was about to unfold! Without giving anything away I can't believe all that happened at the end of "Armageddon" (though it was the end of the book, it was far from the end of the battle). I was left speechless more than once! Although I have spent many hours reading this entire series, and I am ready to move on to whatever I pick next, I have to admit I will miss Chloe, Buck, Rayford, and the rest of the Tribulation Force. I am about to start the 15th book after all! (I started with the three prequels first, which I thought was pretty cool! It gave me the opportunity to really get to know most of the important characters from the day they were born right up to the day of the rapture; including the conception, birth, and adolescence of Nicolae himself.) There may be better rapture series out there (at least that's what I have read from the comments of others), and I will probably check them out too, but The Left Behind series was still worth my time. I would suggest it to just about anybody...religious or not.

I have been steadily reading the Left Behind series and have gathered in so much from them. I am passing the books down to my son and their family. Found out that my daughter-in-law has read books 1-5, two times while waiting for me to finish the 6-11 books! And now I am thinking about rereading them again too! I have talked to my friend in Sacramento about them and she immediately began buying them from thrift stores and getting them from the library for her and her son. She passed me up in her reading and we share the information about prophesy together. It has been a very informative eye opening time for all of us. I suggest this series for all Believers but the second series can be a bit rough for people who are babies in Christ...like my 13 yr. Old grand son.
