

For under \$20, you get a book crammed full of interesting and diverse readings. Philosophy has an "old, rich, white man" problem, as the voices in its tradition usually come only from this demographic. But Guignon adds in black philosopher WEB Du Bois and women philosophers Simone de Beauvoir and Nel Noddings. In addition, there are both analytic philosophers (like Bertrand Russell) and continental philosophers (like Nietzsche and Sartre). The readings are broad and engaging, and even though some of them are dense, Guignon's introductions to a superb job of hitting the major ideas. I couldn't be more pleased with an anthology. It'd be a great adoption for an introduction to philosophy course or courses on the good life, happiness, or the meaning of life.
