The third Chime Traveler takes us a bit ahead in time. The twins have tried and now given up on trying to force an adventure and are going about life in a generally improved way. Peter a boy at school is being mean and nasty to basically everyone. The bishop is coming to visit soon. The stained glass window of St Francis at the parish has had a brick thrown through it and many start to blame Peter. But Fr. Miguel reminds everyone not to lay blame and instead pray for whoever had done such a thing as clearly something is wrong for them. As Patrick is cleaning up the mess, he is taken on a mission to meet St Francis. He arrives in Assisi just before Francis leaves his family and fortune behind. Patrick actually witnesses the voice in San Damiano. They work together to rebuild the church. He also witnesses Francis calm the wolf in the town of his exile. Peter returns home and

applies these lessons in a beautiful way truly learning what it meant to "Rebuild My church". There is a small theme of confession, but not quite sacramental. Wonderful series that teaches a moral lesson, a saint's history, and a touch of Catholic practice. Recommend for all ages!
