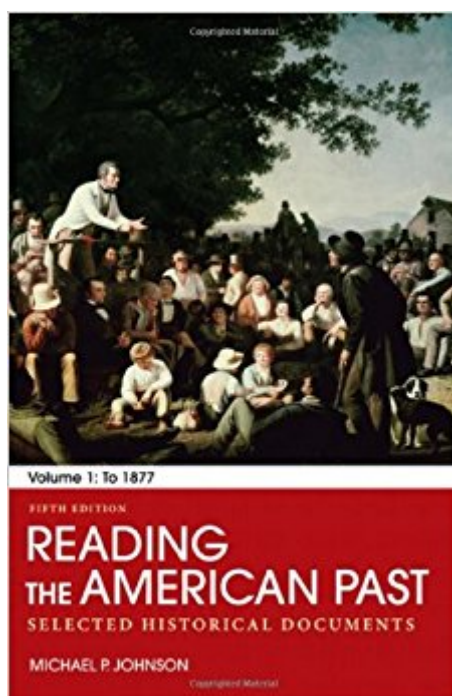

He is the author, co-author, or editor of six books, including *Reading the American Past*, the documents reader designed to accompany *The American Promise*. His research has been honored with fellowships from the National Endowment for the Humanities, the American Council of Learned Societies, the Center for Advanced Study in the Behavioral Sciences, and the Huntington Library, and with prizes from the Organization of American Historians and the Omohundro Institute of Early American History and Culture. He is also the recipient of university

prizes for outstanding undergraduate teaching."
