

This book is obviously not scripture, simply one man's experience. However, I feel that any book that inspires you to live your life closer to the Savior is sacred. This book does just that! I know there are many who discount his visions and challenge things he saw with scripture and words from Latter

Day prophets. I am not sure why they feel the need to do this. "Spencer" is the first to say that this book is not replace the scriptures or words from the Lord's chosen prophets. It is simply an account of his experience. I felt the spirit as I read *Visions of Glory*. I know that this book gave me a spiritual awakening and helped me commit to living the gospel to the fullest! Personally, I think that is a good thing.

I just finished this book up until the appendix. It was an enjoyable book to read. I liked the detailed descriptions of what Spencer saw in his visions. Here are some thoughts: His vision of watching a man giving into his porn addiction made quite an impression on me, especially since being close to loved ones who struggle with this. His words about how departed addicted spirits are still chained to their addictions and stay around living addicts corroborates with other visions I have read. I'm not sure how many other people noticed, but his many of his descriptions of the events leading up to the Second Coming are in line with Sarah Menet's (Hoffman) vision of the end of the world, particularly that the first event is the complete collapse of the US economy, way worse than the Great Depression. Actually this is pretty common among other visions as well. Then the mighty earthquake which practically levels cities and creates massive tsunamis. Sarah say Salt Lake City have a wave of water hit it and it turns out it was because a huge amount of water below the crust of the earth had pushed up. This is precisely how Spencer saw it in his vision. That is the most remarkable part of the book and now these two visions (sarah and spencer) stand out for me as possibly the most accurate of the future. I don't believe Spencer knew about Sarah's vision of this event because the way he describes it, he's at a loss as to why water is coming in from everywhere and then gives his own theory when he finds the huge area of sunken earth afterward. People have mentioned that it is troubling how detailed his vision was and how he perfectly describes everything that he does or happens to him all the way up past the Millennium. I admit I found this troubling as well. It just reads like a novel to me and it's hard for me to imagine that he was able to see and experience it this way. It could have easily been dreamed up to create a sensational story. That's doesn't mean it isn't true just that it is a little harder for me to believe then the rest. Especially the parts about being translated, having an office right next to Jesus in the New Jerusalem temple. This guy isn't even a General Authority, although he says that his work has been in very close proximity to GAs in Salt Lake. Once again, just my feelings, not necessarily an argument or the truth. Overall, I enjoyed the book, although I got tired of the long narrative towards the end. But little things popped up every now and then that grabs my attention. I would definitely recommend this book if you are in to the whole "trying to know of things to come" thing.

Among those who believe that praying about what you read is the ONLY real way to know if this book worth the time it takes to read this volume is no threat. For those who won't pray, don't believe that God answers prayer or just don't believe nothing said here will be of use to you. I'm not some religious fanatic but a 3 degree university professor trained to be skeptical. Read and decide for yourself. I couldn't put it down. The author and editor have placed themselves in a position to endure lots of mockery and criticism. That at least should give one pause before dismissing it.
