

Everyone has given this book a rough go with supposed typos and rampant spelling mistake. The reality is that this book is simply a modern reprint of Peter Whitehorne's 1573 or so English translation. It's not an easy read because a lot of words are spelled differently but after a while it gets easier. If you want a copy of the Art of War written in our contemporary language you will have to look elsewhere. But if you want to read the same text that an Englishman would have read several hundred years ago then this is the text to get.

The translation for this volume is absolutely horrible! I'm returning this book promptly. Full of typos, and misplaced and mismatched letters, it's nearly impossible to read. Avoid this garbage, and get a better translation than this schlocky work! I just cannot believe it would sell this crap to anyone.

The Art of War by Sun Tzu is the oldest military treatise in the world. I think this book should be mandatory reading in the military acadamies.
