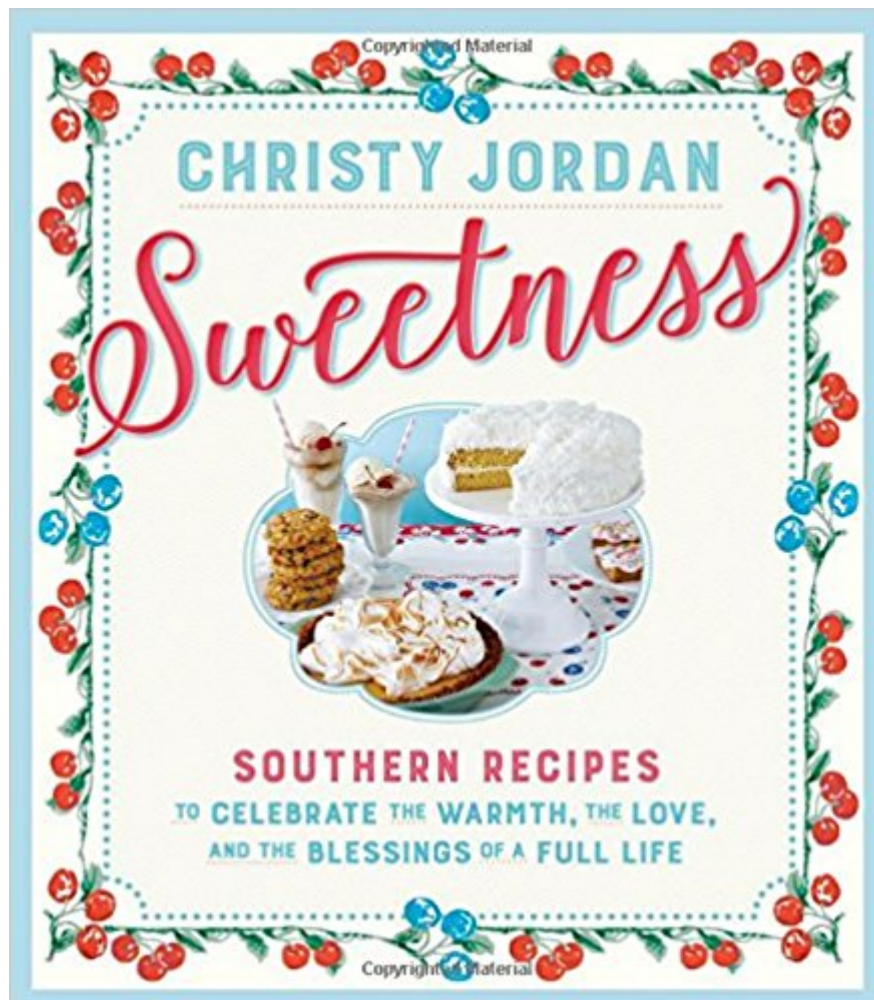




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Sweetness: Southern Recipes To Celebrate The Warmth, The Love, And The Blessings Of A Full Life

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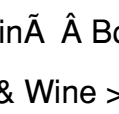
