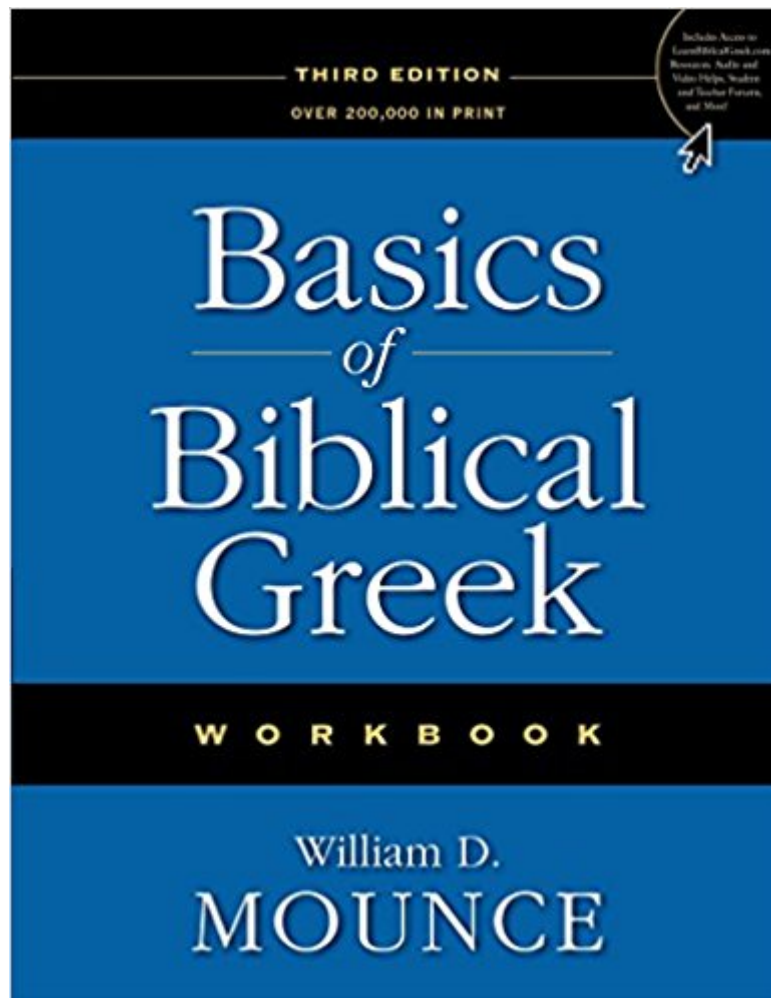

This book has been very helpful in learning Greek. It is easy to follow along with the textbook and the exercises are very effective. The only reason I gave 4 stars is that the description says it is perforated and three hole punched but the copy I received was not so I had to pay to have the binding cut off and had to punch the holes myself to put it in my binder. Other than that, the book is exactly as described and is a very useful tool in learning how to translate Greek.

So, one caution, and this has nothing to do with anything other than the book itself. Some of the sentences / etc that they choose for the workbook exercises are way out there. They introduce grammatical rules / etc that a person wouldn't naturally pick up on and that haven't been introduced in the book. Words? I can understand teaching people to use a Lexicon. For what it's worth, I'm not alone. My professor has a Ph.D. in Greek and he even questions some of the examples used in this book.

Great companion volume to the grammar book by Mounce.

This companion to the Grammar is essential for putting into practice what you learn. Generally, each lesson has several words to parse, some warm ups (which are sentence fragments containing the grammatical concept that the chapter covers), and about 20 short passages to translate. It isn't so much that it is overwhelming, and it is just enough to give yourself good practice to help the grammatical concepts sink in. If you are reading through the Basics of Biblical Greek Grammar, you need this companion to really complete the process!

No better way to learn Greek.

For anyone using Mounce's Basics of Biblical Greek textbook, this workbook is almost a necessity. Translations that are paced for the student are sequenced by chapter and are an easier alternative to translating raw passages of the New Testament. I went through a semester of Greek in college using this workbook; it helped tremendously!
