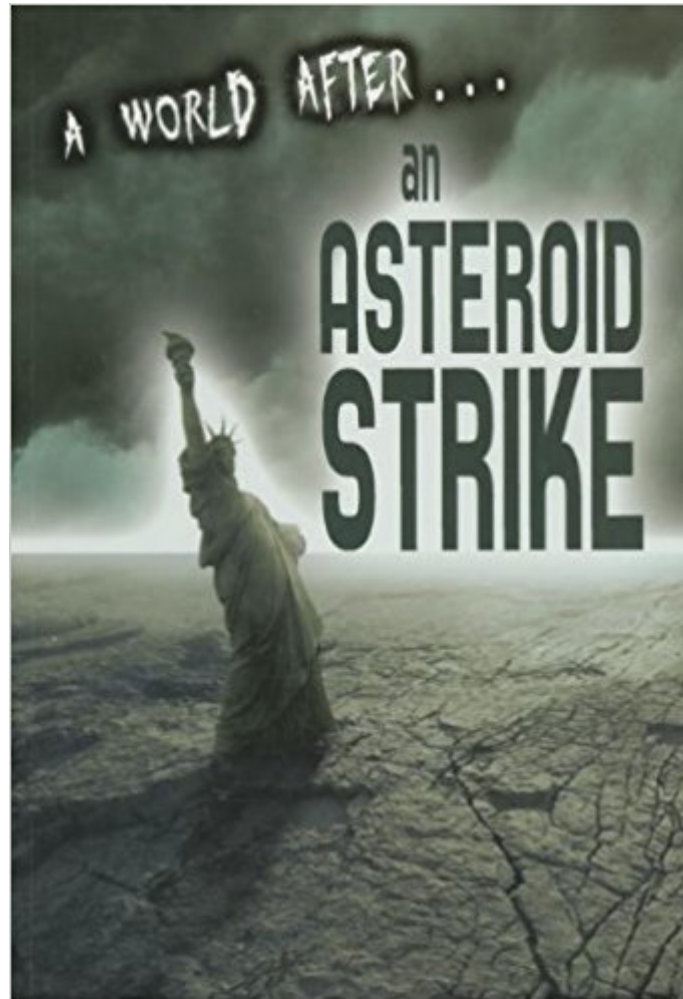

Readers prone to panic attacks should steer clear of the World After series, which conjures up a delightful array of worst-case global scenarios. This one is particularly potent: an asteroid strike that, in Woolf's simulation, zeroes in on the East Coast of America. The ramifications are divided into chunks of time—The First Few Hours, and so on. What do we have to look forward to? Giant electromagnetic pulses, fireballs, shock waves, and tsunamis. Days later comes the darkness, panic, earthquakes, and a government relocation to Colorado. Yes, there is plenty of speculation, but it's backed up by good research, which takes into account both scientific and human factors, and paired with excellent graphics, maps, no-win multiple-choice questions, and even—surprisingly—a few silver linings that (in theory) come out of the experience a decade later.
