

I have the original version of this book, which came out a few years ago, and it's one of my favorites. Needless to say, I was happy to see it being re-released, given the new buildings which have gone up since it came out, or are in the process of going up. This book isn't just a rehash of the first edition- in many cases, it uses new photographs, and in some cases text has been changed. Now, some buildings that were in the previous edition didn't make the cut this time- 100 Park Avenue, New Yorker Hotel, and Marine Midland Bank building, aka 140 Broadway. However there are several new entries here, including the oh-so-controversial 432 Park Avenue and One57. This book also has a couple of pages devoted to the buildings currently under construction (such as Hudson Yards, 425 Park Avenue, and 2 and 3 WTC), all the better to imagine how NYC's skyline is going to change even more in the next few years.
