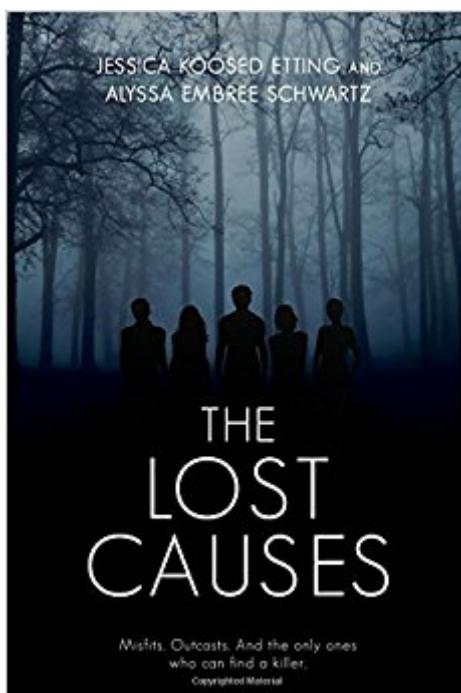

Compulsively readable, *The Lost Causes* sweeps readers into the place where science fiction and mystery meet, ending on a drop-dead cliffhanger that will leave them longing for more.
