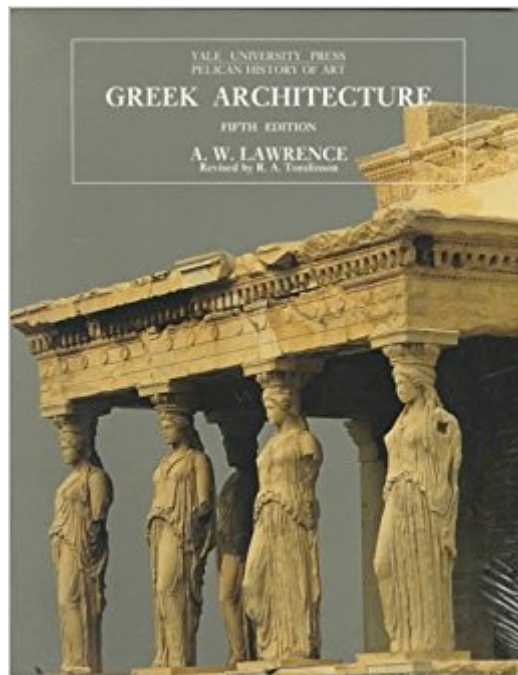


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Greek Architecture, Fifth Edition (The Yale University Press Pelican History Of Art)
